Directly accountable to the Chief Allied Health Officer, coordinates the provision of spiritual care services for Deer Lodge Centre. The Coordinator supports a climate of spiritual healing and comfort for patients/residents, family members, and staff and ensures personal religious and worship needs are met. Acting as a formal and informal resource, the Coordinator assists the Centre in addressing ethical, faith-related, and spiritual matters. Coordinates the work of spiritual care students, volunteers and religious representatives from the community. Performs client care activities as a spiritual care health-care provider.

Education

- Undergraduate degree in theology or an undergraduate degree and one year of theological studies at Master of Divinity level.
- Certified Specialist in Institutional Ministry in good standing with the Canadian Association for Spiritual Care (CASC).

Experience

- Three years of spiritual health-care experience.

Qualifications

- Demonstrates knowledge and support of the spiritual care needs of those in long-term care and their families; current spiritual care practice; continuum of services/community resources; risk management strategies; quality improvement processes; management principles.
- Demonstrated ability to perform both independently and as a team member; prioritize caseloads; respond to a variety of simultaneous demands; plan; manage and implement change; function in a computerized environment.
- Demonstrate effective skill in teaching and leading worship; effective oral and written communication skills; interpersonal, critical thinking, conflict resolution and decision making skills.
